EVANGELISM MOBILIZATION

In 2024, 50 pastors participated in HR Ministries' biblical leadership training and have learned the 30 life principles training. Five young trainees among them have since taken on the initiative to use the training they received to minister on their own in the markets, on the streets, 1-on-1, and in difficult-to-reach areas every Saturday. To assist them with this, we have already purchased portable sound systems with microphones for them to use for their work. We can only imagine what more can be done with this if we continue to invest in them. This development was not something that we had planned or expected by any means, but God has been working in these young people and has made a system of multiplication for His work.

Previously, we were bringing teams from the US to do evangelism in these ways, and these were limited to 3-4 times a year, but because of these young people's hearts, they have started indigenous evangelism programs in their local communities. They are a testimony that God does not just call on the able but enables the called. We are so inspired and grateful for their initiative in mobilizing ministry and evangelism on the ground.

2025 VISION & DIRECTION

We have seen how effective and fruitful the training of these 50 young pastors has been so far. Going forward, we are expanding these teachings into an online leadership training program starting this month. After completing their training, we encourage them to continue going out and training others in their own communities with what they have learned. Ebenezer's role in all of this will be to support them with materials and guidance.

The online training program will be done in partnership with HR Ministries and other pastors. Seeing how impactful this has been, we hope to focus more of our efforts on this going forward. In early April, Ebenezer's board chairman and his team will come and evaluate this program for themselves and can help strengthen this avenue of the ministry.

SCHOOL & ORPHANAGE

Crosspoint School is continuing to grow and develop very quickly. This week marks the start of the second semester of the school year. In the high school, we have 28 students that will sit the national exams this year.

In the orphanage, our seven children are growing up fast! They have been doing well in their schoolwork, and we are encouraged by their progress. Sadly, one of our older boys, Michael's father, passed away this past week. He joined us because his father was bedridden and unable to care for him because he was HIV/AIDS positive. He has a sister that we are currently considering bringing to the orphanage as well and ask for prayer about this matter.



CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

We have been making significant progress on new sporting and recreational facilities on our school grounds, including a soccer field and swimming pool. We plan to use these to launch sporting programs for children. Our main purpose for doing this is because of the lack of access and spaces for children in the region for any positive activities. Many of the students are left to spend their free time outside and on the streets without structure or supervision, and many of them are exposed to very negative lifestyles from a young age because of this. We hope that by offering recreational and athletic opportunities for them, we can begin to positively intervene in their lives from a young age outside of school hours.
